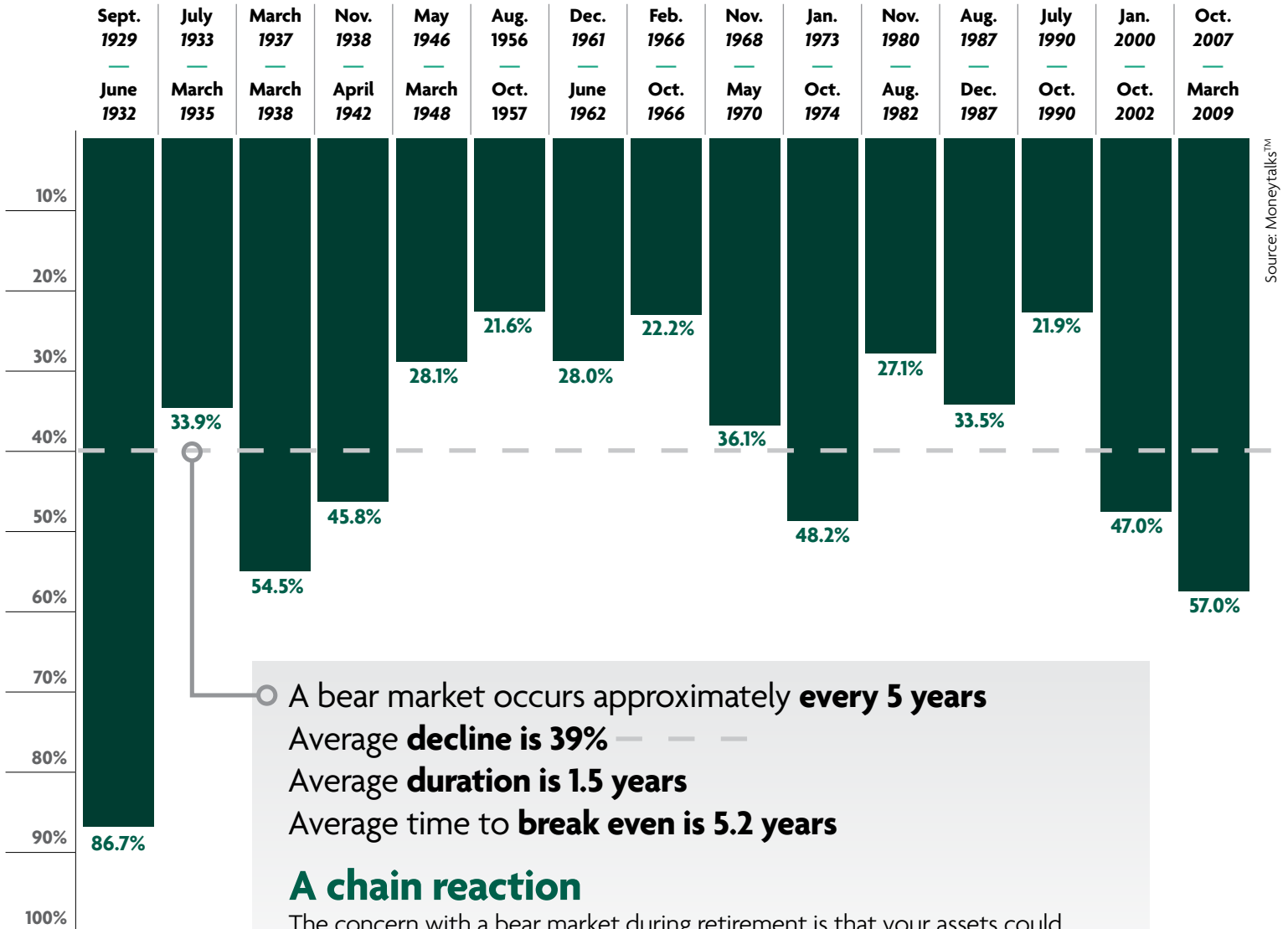


Bear markets

S&P 500® performance



○ A bear market occurs approximately **every 5 years**
 Average **decline is 39%**
 Average **duration is 1.5 years**
 Average time to **break even is 5.2 years**

A chain reaction
